

On September 21, 2023 the Crete Area Historical Society received notice from the National Park Service Network to Freedom (NPS/NTF) that CAHS had been selected as a grant recipient for 2023. We have installed the National Park Service/Network to Freedom sign in front of the Church so we are ready for repairs to start.





Since acquiring the Museum site on August 5, 2022, CAHS has completed numerous projects including:

May 2023 (Illiana Roofing, Beecher)

Tore off the old roofing material, repaired numerous leaks, installed new roofing, added gutters and downspouts where needed.

August 2023 (Areawide Excavating, Crete) Excavated, regraded, drain runoff and gravel was added to the parking lot areas.



October 2023 (Burnham Concrete, Crete)
Built new sidewalks, steps to the Church door
and landing with a handicap accessible ramp
added to the main entrance.

November 2023 (Village of Crete)
Paved, lined and parking bumpers added along the RR tracks to the parking lots.

December 2023 (Powder Coating Creations, Manteno) Exterior light poles have been refurbished and are ready to be installed.

February 2024 (Electric Power Solutions, St. John, IN)
Completed and rerouted the electrical feed to the
Church and Annex sub-panels allowing for conduit
and cable to be removed from the Annex roof side
of the Church

February 2024 (Transystems, Chicago)
3D Laser Scan of entire Church from crawlspace to
the roof. This survey provides a very detailed record of
the existing condition of the floor, and the floor support
structure.

March 2024 (Phil Moeller, Areawide Excavating)
Black dirt has been filled in where needed on the grounds.

April 2024 (G.D. Gazis, Chicago)

Completed the design, plans and specs for a new Church floor system.

Through the work of member volunteers, the following work has been performed

Fall 2022 Insulate the Annex Attic and part of the Church Belfry

2023 - 2024 Construct new supports for the Annex floor system

Winter 2023 - Spring 2024 Remove the existing Church floor and prep for installation of a new floor and floor support system.

This included removing nails and bolts from each board to prepare for storage.

**The Church floor boards are being stored safely for future replacement back into the Church.

**Floor timbers are being removed and will be stored for future display in the Museum.

These are great accomplishments but a significant amount of work remains to be completed before we can open to the public.

A few examples are:

Rebuild the Church floor

Termite extermination of the buildings

Install a lift device to provide handicap access to the Church and Annex from the modern middle building

RESTROOM

Construct a handicap accessible washroom

Restore the Church and Annex windows, which includes the historic stained-glass panels at the top of the Church windows. The names etched in these windows are the Congregation's Founding Members, in which some of them were Conductors on the Underground Railroad.

These are only a few of the projects CAHS plans to undertake in the future. We really could use your help with all future projects. We also appreciate any donations. CAHS is a 501(c)3
